Allied Field Cars in Wehrmacht Service
Bantam BRC-40, Willys MB, Ford GPW, GAZ-64

To a large extent, the German Wehrmacht of World War Two had to rely on captured vehicles to boost its motor pool. Concerning US-built and Soviet-built field cars (the Bantam BRC-40, Willys MB, Ford GPW and GAZ-64 – the “Beutewagen”), their almost microscopic number in German service has meant they have previously avoided monographic documentation. That is, until now. It borders on a small miracle that no fewer than 118 contemporary, in-service photos of US and Soviet field cars in German Army use – after almost 40 years of collecting – could be gathered to cover this hitherto completely uncharted story for the very first time. Adding to the original, wartime photos published in this book are twelve artist’s 3D impressions showing, for the very first time in colour, their most fascinating German camouflage schemes and markings. The wartime photos are almost all previously unpublished and, for better classification and contextualisation in this publication, they are embedded in a brief history of American, German and Soviet field cars of World War Two. This is rounded out by technical walk-arounds and, last but not least, a colour section showing preserved vehicles to please fans and modellers with camouflage, realistic weathering and authentic scenery. Another important gap in World War Two vehicle history is finally closed!

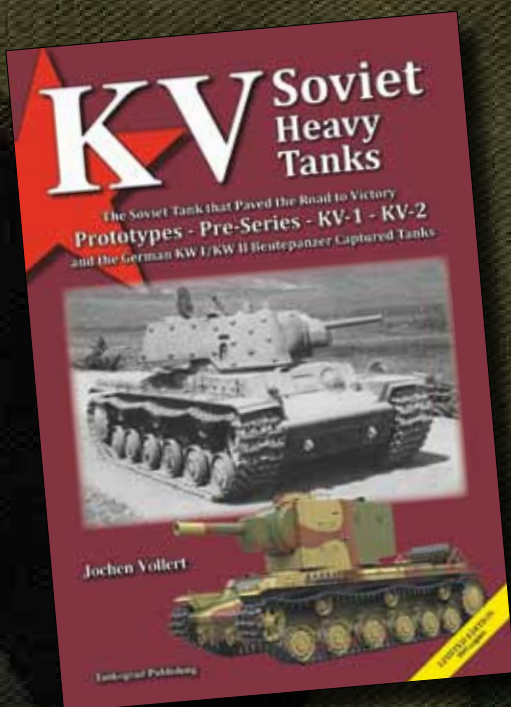

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In 728 pages, supported by 1,030 wartime photographs, 204 other black&white photographs, 345 2-D and 3-D graphics, as well as 18 1/35-scale 5-perspective line drawings plus 32 colour plates and graphics and 45 colour photographs, this is the first ever extensively visual coverage of a tank design that has lived far too long in the shadow of the T-34. British Military Trucks in Wehrmacht Service

Vehicles captured around Dunkirk, in France, Belgium, Greece and North Africa - Service on the Eastern Front, in the West, South and with the Afrikakorps

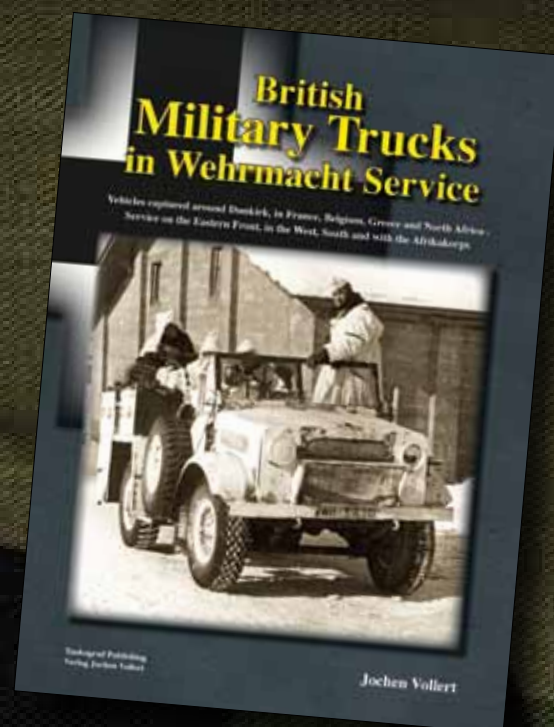
Captured Beutefahrzeuge of British manufacture were a significant addition to Germany's military efforts in the later war years. Without these trucks, many stemming from the Battle of Dunkirk, the German war machine would have been much less capable of waging Blitzkrieg against the Soviet Union from 1941.

While Operation Dynamo, the evacuation from Dunkirk in May and June 1940, made possible the escape of more than 300,000 French and British soldiers, they had to leave all their heavy equipment behind. All in all, the BEF lost around 65,000 vehicles, many of which returned to military service on the German side and doing their duty on the Eastern Front. Other sources for the German Wehrmacht to lay its hands on British trucks to supplement its own forces were Operation Demon in April 1941, the British evacuation from Greece, and the campaign in North Africa from February 1941 to June 1943.

This publication offers for the very first time a comprehensive overview on the various British Trucks in Wehrmacht Service, covering well-known models and makes such as the Bedford and the Morris-Commercial GS trucks in the 8cwt to 3-ton range, the heavy Scammell Pioneers and AEC Matadors, specialised vehicles such as cranes and field cars as well as many rarer makes, rarities and oddities.

A special chapter also grants an overview on the Canadian-built vehicles of the British Army that served with the Afrikakorps.

For all British military vehicle enthusiasts this book is a milestone.

Fahrzeugraritäten 'Hedi' and other Rare and Unusual Vehicles

The main weapon systems of the Imperial German Army in World War One have been covered in past volumes in this series, including panzers, tanks, armoured cars, artillery tractors, anti-aircraft gun carriers, trucks, motorcycles, ambulances and specialised vehicles. In some of these books the author wanted to add chapters that expanded the topics discussed, or to cover the story of certain vehicles that extended beyond the end of the Great War. However, this was not possible if the publications were to stay within their economic frame. This book now closes many of these gaps - Each of the following chapters represents the first-ever comprehensive coverage on the topic!:

The tracked transport vehicle chapter comprehensively covers the *Überlandwagen*, *Dür-Wagen*, *Orion-Wagen* and *Lanz Gleiskettenschlepper* fully tracked lorries as well as fully tracked and half-tracked trucks. With the 'Hedi' anti-riot tank, one follows the A7V panzer's history into the turbulent post-war *Freikorps* era, including the first detailed scale drawing. The chapter on *Straßenlokomotiven* provides extensive coverage of wartime steam-powered road locomotives by Fowler-Magdeburg, Kemna, Lanz, Heuke and others, with these machines used to haul super-heavy siege artillery. It is supplemented with a brief chapter on steam-powered trucks by Badenia and Wolf. Another topic covers the use of cargo trucks for field artillery transport and as self-propelled guns during the war. The chapter on *Daimler, Ehrhardt and Benz Schupo-Sonderwagen* and the *Gepanzerter Kraftwagen* finally expands the limited story of German World War One armoured cars into their much more exciting usage with the post-war anti-riot police, and even up into *Reichswehr* service.

Zum sechsten Mal führten die amerikanischen Streitkräfte vom 30. September bis 22. November 1974 ein REFORGER-Manöver durch. Neben der REFORGER-Verlegetübung wurde die Korpsgefechtsübung "Certain Pledge" unter Leitung des VII (US) Corps in Stuttgart mit Beteiligung der amerikanischen, kanadischen und westdeutschen Streitkräfte durchgeführt. Auf Basis und im Szenario der bisherigen REFORGER-Übungen wurde auch bei "REFORGER VI" die Verstärkung der in Deutschland stationierten amerikanischen Landstreitkräfte und der NATO geübt. Der Übungsanteil (Field Training Exercise/FTX) Certain Pledge war eine groß angelegte Gefechtsübung, an der insgesamt 28 Kampftruppen- und 17 Artilleriebataillone teilnahmen, die mit rund 45.000 Soldaten sowie 8.000 Rad- und 4.000 Kettenfahrzeugen und circa 250 Hubschraubern im Feld standen. Darunter waren auch Verbände der 4 Canadian Mechanized Brigade Group und, als einziger Großverband der Bundeswehr, die verstärkte Panzerbrigade 30 aus Ellwangen.

Vorliegende Publikation zeigt in eindrucksvollen, bisher meist unveröffentlichten Manöverfotos die eingesetzten Fahrzeuge und den Ablauf der Übung.



From 30 September to 22 November 1974, US armed forces conducted a REFORGER manoeuvre for the sixth time. In addition to the REFORGER deployment exercise, the corps exercise Certain Pledge (the field training part) was carried out under the direction of VII (US) Corps in Stuttgart, with the participation of soldiers from American, Canadian and West German armed forces. Based on the scenario of previous REFORGER exercises, "REFORGER VI" also involved practising the reinforcement of American land forces stationed in Germany and NATO. The field training exercise Certain Pledge was a large-scale corps-level event in which 28 combat battalions and 17 artillery battalions took part, with around 45,000 soldiers, 8,000 wheeled and 4,000 tracked vehicles, and around 250 helicopters in the field. Among them were units of 4 Canadian Mechanized Brigade Group and, as the only large unit of the Bundeswehr, the reinforced Panzerbrigade 30 from Ellwangen.

This publication shows, in impressive and hitherto mostly unpublished photos, the involved vehicles and the stages of the exercise.
